SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

AUDITS

An Infection Control Inspection was carried out in house by ANP Lucy Blamire in MAY 24 The purpose of the audit was to ensure appropriate systems are in place for patients/service users and to ensure risk of infection is kept to a minimum.

Cleaning Audit Score from NHS Property Services Score achieved on all areas above 90%

The assessment tool used by Lucy Blamire/IPC lead Charmaine Donnelly for all clinical areas was the IPC Hampshire and Isle of Wight Audit Tool

Areas for Improvement are:

Clutter/personal items found in some GP rooms requiring removal to allow full cleaning process to occur as per guidance
Ensuring Re-cycling Card board is removed daily by Cleaning team

Provision for environmental cleaning of building to be assessed and areas of concerns highlighted to cleaning providers ongoing
